



The Dutch **HRM Network Award 2009** has been awarded to Prof. dr. Luc Sels (Faculty of Business and Economics, Katholieke Universiteit Leuven). Reference was made to his role in the development of the HRM field in Europe, his international publications and contribution to the translation of HRM theory to HR practice.

The ceremony took place at the Sixth **International HRM Network Conference**, which was held at the Vrije Universiteit and the Universiteit van Amsterdam on the 13th and 14 of November 2009. At each International HRM Network Conference the Award is presented to an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the HRM field.
