

## Bio-sketch Hylke Vandenbussche

Hylke Vandenbussche is a Professor in International Economics and holder of the Chaire Jacquemin at the Université Catholique de Louvain. She held visiting positions at the University of Cambridge, Dartmouth College, Tilburg, Warwick, Leuven and LSE. Her research interests lie in trade, trade policy, competition issues, antidumping measures and firm performance. Her papers have been published in journals like the *Journal of International Economics*, *European Economic Review*, *European Journal of Political Economy*, *Oxford Economic Papers*, *World Economy*, *Journal of World Trade* and others. She (co-)edited a book on “The WTO and Antidumping” with Edward Elgar Publishers. She is a research fellow of the Centre for Economic Policy Research, London and a member of the Scientific Committee of the Midwest International Meetings and European Trade Study Group. She has collaborated on policy reports for the European Parliament and the Treasury in the UK. She is also an advisor to the Ministry of External Affairs in Belgium since 2002.
